Categories for oral presentation include: Advocacy, Asthma in Schools, Environment, Epidemiology & Surveillance, Local Coalition Activities, Medical Management, Patient Education and Quality Improvement.

A SAMPLE ABSTRACT WITH COMPLETE TYPING

INSTRUCTIONS (Paste your abstract in this window following the format below)

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PURPOSE: Your abstract will be published in the program and posted on the ACT website exactly as it appears in your original. ACT is not responsible for author errors. Abstracts may be reformatted for publication so that all abstracts appear in uniform type. By following the instructions, you will guarantee that your abstract will appear as you intended.

METHODS: All abstracts must fit in a 5 x 7-inch box (this size). Only e-mail submissions will be accepted. Submit abstracts to BLACHM@parknet.pmh.org. The Abstract Submission Form can be found at ACT's website, <http://www.texasasthma.org>. Use *Times Roman* 12-point font, or equivalent (this type). Do not reduce or condense the type. Type your title in boldface capital letters. Begin the author list and the affiliation of the presenting author on a new line, as shown. The name of the presenting author should be underlined. Skip one line and begin typing the abstract **using the structured format and headings exactly as shown**. Begin each section on a new line, with headings **exactly as shown**. Abstracts must be single-spaced. **Submissions must be in Microsoft Word format.**

RESULTS: Your abstract must be received by August 13, 2010. No FAX OR MAIL submissions will be accepted. You will be notified of abstract receipt by e-mail.

CONCLUSION: To be considered, abstracts must be prepared following these instructions.

Abstracts must be received by August 13, 2010. Your meeting registration must be received before September 3, 2010 to secure a poster board at the meeting and placement in the final meeting program. Again, **FAX AND MAIL submissions will NOT be accepted.** Abstracts are for projects/programs and NOT for commercial vendors.
